# Tetila Plus<sup>MkII</sup>

**FEATURES**

- A low cost blend of annual tetraploid ryegrass and high quality clovers.
- Early to Mid Maturity
- Good seedling vigour to out-compete weeds and give early feed
- Easy to establish for new pastures or oversowing run down pastures
- High level of digestability and sugars
- Good regrowth and option for silage and hay pastures
- Gaucho and Poncho Plus treatment options available

**AREA OF ADAPTION**  
Medium to High rainfall zones.

**SOIL TYPE**  
Tetila Plus is well adapted to a wide range of fertility levels and soil types. Tetraploid annuals will cope with short term waterlogging provided the growth tip is above water. To maximise stand productivity soil testing is advisable via NutriScription. Analyse soil and neutralise deficiencies with fertiliser and/or lime.



**INOCULATION**  
Sow with Group C granular legume inoculant from BASF or Alosca to maximise the nitrogen fixation of the clover species.



**SEED MIX**

Tetila Plus MkII	
Ryegrass 80%	Clovers 20%
Tetila and Attain (mid tetraploid)	Trikkala sub clover, Paradana balansia, Arrowleaf clover

**SOWING**

Sow at 25kg/ha. Sow seed no deeper than 1cm in a fine but firm seed bed. Sow into bared ground if direct drilling. Lightly harrow and roll to improve germination. Suitable for oversowing into an established stand. Pasture productivity is directly related to successful plant establishment.

**TREATING**

Apply Poncho Plus or Gaucho to have a proactive approach to pest control. Seed insecticide treatments will maximise stocking rates from sowing as quickly as possible and protect beneficial species. Choose either to treat the entire blend or clovers only.
