With 9,500 sheep on offer, quite a few more than advertised, the usual buying group and some re-stockers attended the third market in November with vendors and a number of on-lookers filling the aisles. Most classes of stock sold from firm to stronger demand, due to less numbers coming available in the coming months.

Less selection came forward on all classes offered, but sold to stronger demand than previous market due to less numbers being available to select from and the more feed available in a number of areas.

Merino wether lambs came forward, along with a selection of shorn & woolly crossbred lambs; Young Ewes came forward in less numbers & a smaller selection of breeding ewes.

Lambs presented in store condition with a number of lambs presenting in good forward condition. Most lines of young ewes and breeding ewes presented in store condition with only a handful of lines being in good forward condition.

Once again values were very much based on stock with condition, body weight & maturity for all classes of stock.

Young 2017 drop merino ewes made to a top of \$202 for a line of 120 J/A Leahcim Blood Merino ewes from Aramaa Props, these were the only outstanding line of ewes to be offered.

RF & JA McInnis offered 150 J/J 16D March Shn Ewes, making \$188.
