Landmark reports a total of 28371 sheep and lambs at Katanning on the 05.12.2018.

Quality was mixed but lamb and mutton quality was good with most being heavy ewes and most lambs were light trade to heavy lambs.

Best sales were from \$145 - \$160 with light trade lambs from \$115 - \$135, while light stores sold strongly from \$80 - \$105.

Ewe mutton remained firm over all grades with heavy bare shorn ewes selling up to \$128, with most sales from \$105 - \$115. Light boning ewes sold from \$65 - \$80.

Wethers this week saw good support from re-stockers with most sales from \$95 - \$105, with heavy types going to the trade at \$115 - \$125.

Ewe hogget quality was good with most being killing types selling from \$105 - \$120 with lighter types from \$65 - \$85.

Rams were in larger numbers this week with most sales from \$40 - \$70.
