Landmark reports a smaller yarding of 12354 sheep and lambs at Katanning on the 19.12.2018.

The yarding consisted of mainly store to light trade crossbred lambs with only small numbers of ewe mutton penned.

Heavy crossbred lambs remained firm but lacked weight on last week with best sales to \$155. Store and trade lambs rose \$4 - \$5 with strong trade and grazier competition with limited support on light store lambs.

Ewe mutton fell \$5 - \$8 due to competition with most processors closed for the Christmas break. Most heavy weight sales sold from \$100 - \$115 with boning ewes remaining firm selling from \$75 - \$95.

Ewe hogget numbers were down on previous week and sold from \$75 - \$95.

Rams remained firm with very limited numbers penned.
