

MUCHEA SHEEP REPORT 29th JANUARY 2019

This week's Muchea trade sale saw numbers up on last week by 1,440 to see a total yarding of 9,747 offered and sold of which 3101 lambs and 4060 mutton the larger offerings. All buyers of the trade were back in the market.

Lambs showed good weights and quality and saw a sale top of \$161.50 with most better sales ranging from \$140. Trade weight lambs sold between \$133 and \$140.50. Better quality store lambs, mostly Merino types, came to hand today and saw good enquiry to close \$4 to \$6 higher than last quotes.

Mutton saw good quality weights in the top end with a top of \$150.50 to Graziers and \$135 to the trade. Boners and light weight mutton saw mixed quality and closed back \$2 to \$5.

Limited ewe hoggets were suitable for the trade and this allowed Graziers to purchase suitable replacement and sold between \$90 and \$156.50 for a line 'in the wool'. Lighter lines were still sought after ranged between \$50 and \$90.

Wethers rose \$3 to \$7 under very good grazier support with a line, 'in the wool', selling for \$155.50 with better lines ranging from \$130.50. Light and plain drafts were sought after with values between \$85 and \$112 with spirited bidding.

Rams were limited in numbers and remained unchanged in values.
