With 14,000 sheep on offer, a few more than advertised, a slender crowd attended the only market for December, with vendors, on-lookers and quite a few agents filling the aisles. Most classes of stock sold to firm or cheaper demand, with lighter, plainer secondary types

selling to very stiff competition.

More lines of merino wether lambs came forward, along with more selection of heavier feeder weight lambs. Along with a good quality XB lambs selling to very strong competition.

Young Ewes came forward in less numbers with a lack of quality offered selling to subdued demand.

Breeding Ewes also came forward in less numbers with ewes presenting in plainer condition meaning demand was lacking due to minimal paddock feed available.

Once again values were very much based on stock with condition, body weight & maturity for all classes of stock.

Stock that required paddock time and paddock feed sold to lesser rates compared to past markets.

The best breeding ewes presented in good condition also, with a number of plainer types coming forward due to dryer conditions.
