Landmark reports a larger yarding of 23086 sheep and lambs at Katanning. Quality overall was mixed with most lines being forward store types with limited numbers of heavy killing lambs, but the ewe mutton did have weight and also larger numbers of boning ewes.

Heavy crossbred lambs fell \$4 - \$5 due to quality while light trade lambs also fell \$4 - \$5, while light stores proving hard to sell.

Ewe mutton fell \$5 - \$8 mainly on heavy ewes while trade and boning ewes remained firm.

Ewe hoggets this week remained firm with most sales from \$80 - \$115.

Merino lambs were in mostly store condition with most sales from \$45 - \$70.

Rams again sold strongly with most sales from \$40 - \$80.
