Landmark reports a larger yarding of 19734 sheep and lambs at Katanning on the 13.03.2019. Larger numbers of ewe mutton and good numbers of trade and heavy crossbred lambs were yarded, while there were also larger numbers of store crossbred lambs.

Heavy crossbred lambs remained firm this week. Trade lambs sold strongly while light stores rose \$3 - \$4.

Ewe mutton remained firm on heavy lines while good boning ewes rose \$5 - \$8 in a strong market. Also, very light ewes rose \$5 - \$8.

Ewe hoggets this week saw larger numbers with strong grazier and trade support. Most sales were from \$110 - \$125 with lighter types rising \$5 - \$6.

Merino lambs this week were of mixed quality and remained firm over most grades.

Ram numbers this week were larger with good younger rams rising \$3 - \$4 selling up to \$118, while medium and killing rams sold from \$40 - \$70.
