Landmark reports another large yarding of 25,756 sheep and lambs at Katanning on the 15th May 2019.

The yarding was made up of mainly crossbred lambs and merino lambs with limited numbers of ewe mutton.

Heavy crossbred lambs remained firm. Trade lambs also remained firm while light trade lambs fell \$5-8.

Ewe mutton rose \$4-5 on heave types due to quality and competition with best sales up to \$155. Most sales were from \$95 - \$115. Light and plain types sold from \$55 - \$75.

Export wethers saw only one exporter operating with most heavy wethers sold from \$115 - \$130. Store wethers in limited numbers sold from \$75 - \$85.

Merino wether lambs in large numbers saw the market remain firm with best sales from \$120 - \$135 while stores sold from \$75 - \$85.

Rams in limited numbers remained firm with most sales from \$70 - \$90.
