KATANNING SHEEP REPORT 5th JUNE 2019

Landmark reports a total yarding of 14,448 sheep and lambs at Katanning on the 5th June 2019. The yarding consisted of mainly lambs with also good numbers of merino ewe mutton.

Heavy crossbred lambs were in limited numbers but did sell up to \$289 with most heavy sales from \$190 - \$220. Trade lambs remained firm with most sales from \$150 - \$180. Light trade lambs sold from \$95 - \$140 depending on weight and size.

Ewe mutton fell \$5-\$10 over most grades with best heavy sales from \$140 - \$165. Boning ewes mainly sold from \$110 - \$130 while very light and plain ewes sold from \$55 - \$75.

Merino wethers were in larger numbers and sold from \$110 - \$145 while stores sold from \$80 - \$95. Merino lambs in large numbers saw mainly stores yarded but good killing types sold from \$135 - \$165 while stores sold from \$75 - \$105.

Rams remained firm with most sales from \$50 - \$90.
