

## **Mt Barker Trade Cattle 05/09/19**

Numbers were down for a small yarding of 426 mainly good quality store conditioned cattle at Mt Barker. Medium weight weaner steers topped the market at 338c closely followed by light weight yearling steers at 336c/kg. Heavy prime cows sold to a top of 266c while heavy bulls eased topping at 248c/kg.

Grown steers weighing between 500 and 600kg sold for 296c while the lighter under 500kg steers made from 290c to 304c /kg.

Heifers over 540kg sold for 250c to 288c while the lighter weight heifers made from 250c to 278c /kg.

Yearling steers sold from 274c to 336c for the best averaging 307c/kg while the heifers made 252c to 292c to average 263c/kg.

Weaner steers sold for 282c to 338c to average 327c/kg while weaner heifers returned 210c to 280c /kg.

Heavy prime cows gained 12c to sell from 228c to 266c to average 247c/kg.

Medium weight cows eased 2c making from 208c to 234c while boners sold for 150c to 228c averaging 193c /kg.

Prime heavy bulls eased 6c making from 224c to 248c averaging 241c and light weight bulls made 230c to 242c to average 236c/kg.
